Bubble Rush Terms and Conditions

Please read these terms and conditions carefully and make sure that you understand them before completing your registration. You should understand that by submitting your registration form, you agree to be bound by these terms for yourself and all those you are registering.

Definitions

- **“My Party”, “My Party’s”, “Your Party” or “Your Party’s”** - every individual registered in the single event booking.

General

These booking terms and conditions apply to everyone who takes part in Bubble Rush, and those who attend as spectators. The terms and conditions contain important information regarding participation, and upon entry you agree to and accept these terms and conditions.

I agree:

- By taking part in The Bubble Rush My Party do so at their own risk. In no event shall North West Air Ambulance Charity, Demelza House Trading Ltd or Off Limits Ltd, the sponsors or supporters of the event be liable for any injuries, loss or damages whatsoever, including indirect, punitive, special, incidental or consequential losses connected with any aspect of this event.
- If necessary, any member of My Party should gain advice from their GP as to whether they are physically prepared to undertake the challenge.
- Photographs and/or videos will be taken of participants throughout the event which will be used on promotional materials. It is my responsibility to let staff know at registration that a member(s) of My Party do not want to appear in any such materials.
- Photographs and/or videos may also be used for the brand of Bubble Rush. Demelza House Trading Ltd, is the owner of the Bubble Rush brand.
- The North West Air Ambulance Charity may use without payment, notice, or further consent any photographs, videos and other images in which you appear which are taken at the event

Registration

I understand:

- The entry fee is non-refundable and non-transferable. Transfer of waves is also not permitted or guaranteed.
- There is no minimum age limit however under 16's must be accompanied by a responsible adult who has registered for the event.
- Children aged 15 or under are charged a child's ticket entry fee. Anyone aged 16 and over will be charged an adult ticket entry fee. Prices vary.

- Children aged 3 and under will be £4 but will not receive a t-shirt. They will receive a medal and wristband. If you would like them to have a t-shirt, please register them as a child aged 15 or under.
- The registration fee contributes largely to the cost of staging Bubble Rush and includes your entry pack and fundraising materials.
- North West Air Ambulance Charity will use the email address that you have supplied, to send you information about this event and also events that North West Air Ambulance Charity may organise in the future. - For post and telephone: Please note that as you are signing up for one of our events, it may be necessary for us to contact you for administrative purposes, about this event.
- The information you provide at registration will be shared only with that organisation, it will not be shared with any other organisation. Your data will be processed in accordance with the [North West Air Ambulance Charity's privacy policy](#).

Sponsorship

I understand:

- There is no minimum sponsorship requirement for this event however North West Air Ambulance Charity asks that all participants try to raise at least £15 if possible.
- Sponsor forms are included in my welcome email and [must be returned as soon as possible after the Bubble Rush, along with all the fantastic funds raised. There will also be a donation station at the event where you can drop these off on your way to the bubbles!
- I agree to returning all sponsorship and donations received to North West Air Ambulance Charity within 6 weeks of the event date. By doing so, North West Air Ambulance Charity can make sure that we can remain operational 365 days a year.
- All funds raised by My Party's participation in this event in support of North West Air Ambulance Charity are raised for the sole purpose and benefit of North West Air Ambulance Charity (registered charity no.1075641 and those who receive the support from its services.
- My Party is not permitted to use any of the sponsorship money that they raise in relation to the Bubble Rush event to pay for their expenses. If they do not pass all the money, they raise to North West Air Ambulance Charity they may be committing a criminal offence.

Safety

I understand:

- Your Party's safety is of paramount importance. Please ensure that you follow all safety instructions and training procedures when participating in events.
- Children aged 15 years and under must take part alongside a paying adult and be accompanied throughout the event. School and youth groups who take part must have adequate supervision.

- Upon running through the Bubble Stations, all children must be accompanied by an adult who will be responsible for their safety at this point. Small children may need to be lifted through some parts of the bubble stations, and we recommend they wear swimming goggles/sunglasses to protect their eyes.
- The route is pushchair and wheelchair friendly, but if you have any concerns please contact the North West Air Ambulance Charity Events Team on events@nwairambulance.org.uk.
- On no account is alcohol to be brought into the event site or consumed during the event. North West Air Ambulance Charity reserves the right to refuse entry to anyone under the influence of alcohol.
- No animals of any kind are allowed to participate in the Bubble Rush. This is in the best interest and safety of your family pet and all those participating.
- Bubble Rush involves a level of sustained physical activity. Participants make the decision to take part and must be satisfied that this activity is suitable for them as individuals. Neither North West Air Ambulance Charity nor its affiliates can be held accountable for aggravation to illness or injury sustained due to participation in this activity.
- It is recommended that if Your Party has any health concerns that they contact their GP before participating. We also recommend that if a member of Your Party is pregnant that they do not participate in the event.
- For Your Party's safety and enjoyment of the Bubble Rush, we ask that Your Party follows and adheres to the instructions given by the event organisers and event marshals.

About the Foam

I understand:

- The foam mixture is completely natural and safe. It is advisable that younger children wear swimming goggles or sunglasses, as they may be head deep at most bubble stations.
- Members of My Party need to be careful when wiping their eyes with their hands if they have frothy suds all over them too. Marshalls will have towels to help with this.
- The coloured foam is made from food dye and is water soluble as well as environmentally friendly. There is a chance that this foam may stain some lighter coloured pushchairs and clothes. It is advisable to bring towels to sit on in the car on your journey home – to avoid any possible stains.
- If any member of My Party has any skin conditions, we would recommend they speak to their GP before participating.
The bubble operators at each station are professionally trained and will not shoot foam directly at faces.
- North West Air Ambulance Charity does not take any responsibility for any damage to any clothing or items belonging to the participants. Participants take part at their own risk.

What Should I Wear?

- I have been advised to wear appropriate footwear to this event to ensure my safety when participating.

I understand that:

- Due to the nature of the dyes used in the bubbles these may stain clothing. It is My Party's responsibility to come suitably dressed for the event. The event organisers take no responsibility for colour stains on any shoes, clothing or any other belongings.
- In order to protect my eyes while running through the foam stations My Party has been advised to wear protective sunglasses or goggles.
- Participants can take part with a pushchair however My Party is aware that the route takes place on uneven ground and that the foam could stain the fabric. In some areas it is advised to carry children through the foam.
- It is advised to bring a change of clothes and shoes, as well as a towel and that there are no changing facilities provided at the venue.

Cancellation & Event Amendments

- North West Air Ambulance Charity reserves the right to cancel this event at any time. In the event of this happening, participants will be able to request a refund.
- North West Air Ambulance Charity reserves the right to postpone this event at any time. In the event of this happening, North West Air Ambulance Charity will automatically transfer your booking to the postponed event and refunds are not guaranteed.
- North West Air Ambulance Charity reserves the right to alter the start time of the event at any time.
- If the Bubble Rush is cancelled because of circumstances of force majeure, participants will not be entitled to any refund of the entry fee and/or compensation of other losses, such as travelling or accommodation expenses.

Disclaimer

- My Party agrees as participants taking part in the North West Air Ambulance Charity Rush, that they do so at their own risk. In no event shall North West Air Ambulance Charity be liable for any injuries, loss or damages whatsoever.
- My Party will not engage in any form of ambush marketing (ambush marketing is an activity by a party which utilises the publicity values of an event without having any official involvement or connection with the event) and shall not breach or infringe the rights of any sponsor or other party commercially associated with the Bubble Rush, nor conduct unauthorised promotions or other commercial activity.
