Important things to remember for Gift Aid

-  **25% extra** – Remind your sponsors that Gift Aid means UK taxpayers can add an extra 25% to their sponsorship at no extra cost to them.
-  **Handwriting** - Make sure your sponsors fill in their details in their own handwriting. Forms in the same handwriting are not valid for Gift Aid.
-  **Home Address** – Your sponsors must provide their full home address and postcode and not a work address in order for us to claim Gift Aid.

£100

could save the life of a seriously ill patient by buying a surgical airway kit, enabling our crew to establish a patient airway during certain life-threatening situations, such as airway obstruction or facial trauma.

£50

could provide one set of Rapid Sequence Intubation (RSI) drugs used by the crew to manage a patients airway.

£25

could buy a warming blanket, which is essential to maintain the body temperature of severe trauma patients.

£9

could fund one minute of a North West Air Ambulance Charity mission.
