1. Promoter

2. Opening and Closing Date

- The opening date for entries is 12 noon 20th April 2026. The closing date of the early bird prize draw is Midnight on 18th May 2026 inclusive. Entries received after this time will not be counted or accepted.

3. Eligibility

- The Early Bird Draw is open to all entrants who purchase a raffle ticket before the Early Bird Draw Closing Date, this date will also be stated on the raffle pack and our marketing channels.
- Entrants must be aged 18 or over and reside in Great Britain (excluding Northern Ireland, Channel Islands, Isle of Man and BFPO addresses).
- Staff of NWAA and FONWAA that work in connection with our Lottery and Raffles are prohibited to play.

- All eligible entries received by the Early Bird Draw Closing Date will be automatically entered into the Early Bird Draw.
